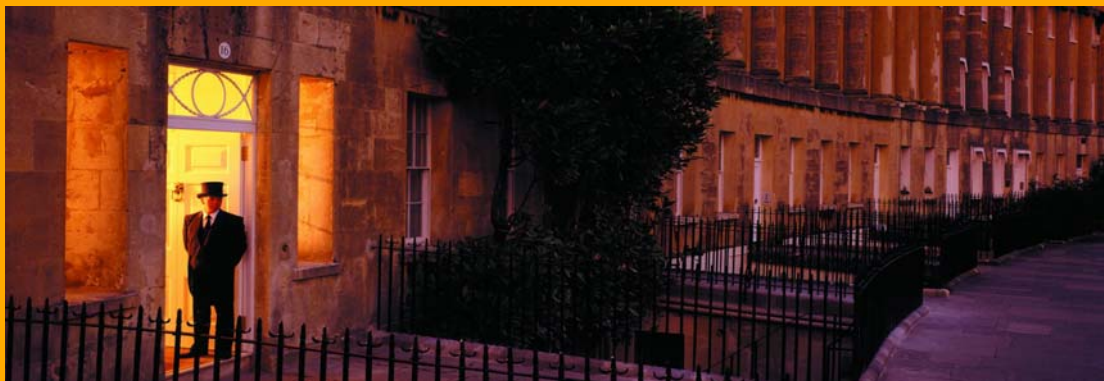

Suggested day trips

(routes marked on map below)

2 - blue route

4 - green route

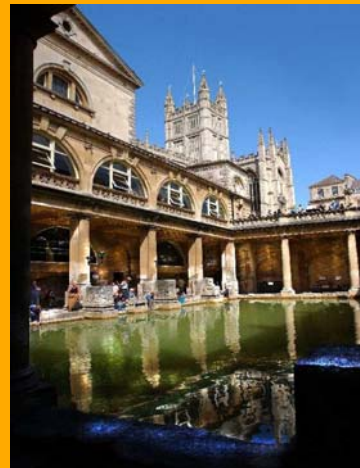
Head across to visit the picturesque villages of Castle Combe and Lacock today, with a visit to Avebury Stone Circle.
